Dear Parents,

"It is not easy being a kid these days, especially as part of a family experiencing unemployment or homelessness. Branson has more than 2,000 working poor with over 400 children living in substandard, weekly-stay motel rooms. Our community's kids deserve better."

The above quote is from the website for ELEVATE KIDS, Branson's response to assisting the children of the working poor in their community.

We typically think of Branson, Missouri, as the center of wholesome, family entertainment that boosts tourism and is a wonderful economic experience for the Branson area during its peak "inseason" months. However, there is a downside. Being that tourism is seasonal, employment can be scarce in the off-season. The majority of the jobs in this industry offer lower wages and inconsistent hours, with no health insurance or opportunities for advancement. Unemployment, housing, health, and nutritional struggles are very real for families in Branson and throughout the entire Taney County area.

Compared to other counties in Missouri, Taney County has an unusually high number of residents working in traditionally low wage occupations like the hotel and food service industry. While unemployment in the State of Missouri runs at an average of 4.4%, unemployment in Taney County is 33.4%. And of course, the face of poverty is predominantly female and children. These kids deserve better!

ELEVATE KIDS Includes a variety of programs and services to help young children have healthy meals and renew their mind, body and spirit. The money raised for this year's 2025 *Lenten Youth Project* will help to build a safe playground for them to play. The program will include basketball, climbing nets, swings, picnic tables and slides. This will certainly put a smile on their faces.

The funds raised during this 2025 *Lenten Youth Project*, along with prayer, will be a beautiful example of "children helping children" in our diocese. And, next time you're in Branson, you can visit the ELEVATE KIDS playground!
